

Miss Monroe Ill but Not 'Expecting'

Actress Marilyn Monroe, recuperating yesterday at her home following her collapse on a 20th Century-Fox movie set late Tuesday, said she's not expecting "a little baseball player."

The blond actress denied reports that she is expecting a baby and explained her collapse as a case of "nerves and overwork."

A studio spokesman said Miss Monroe had not been feeling well since her return here from Korea where she performed before servicemen. It was the third time she had been ill since the picture was started.

She is expected to return to work possibly tomorrow.

"I'm not expecting a little baseball player yet," she said, "but that doesn't mean that Joe (her husband, Joe DiMaggio) and I don't want one."
